It's A 3D ART ADVENTURE!!! Our artist will explore several mediums of clay, paper mâché, plastic, metal, mosaics, glass, resin, magazines, foam, tissue, wire, fiber and upcycled materials to create 3D sculptures, mobiles, bowls, wall hangings, cardboard, and other super cool projects. Artists will learn about art history, art styles and be inspired by some of the greatest artists from around the world. On the last day our young artists will have their very own gallery showing the art they made from camp with their friends and family.



Fashionista & SPA-tacular Camp (July 15-19)

For the FABULOUS who love FASHION, DIY's and all things SPA-tacular!

Do you have your own awesome sense of style? Campers will have so much fun designing, decorating and up-cycling one-of-a-kind pieces of clothing, and accessories. Our Fashionistas' will take a walking field trip to the local Goodwill and a specialty boutique to learn the art of styling, fashion trends, merchandising, visual display, and fabrications. They will put together a fashion inspiration board and their own personal "Look Book". We will be learning basic fashion illustration and design, as well as, tie dying, sewing (hand stitching) bleaching, painting jean jackets, creating designer jeans with patches, rhinestones, and paint, designing hats, handbags, and shoes. They will also make their own gorgeous accessories (hair, earrings, necklace, bracelets, rings, backpack accessories, jewelry holder, and home décor for their room. Every day

will be an adventure in creative expression that will result in a collection of signature pieces and a Fashion Show on the last day. You must provide jeans, jean shorts/skirt, a jean jacket or pay an extra \$50 and I can get it for your designer in her size when we go shopping at Goodwill. We will provide two t-shirts, white tennis shoes to upcycle and all of the other embellishments and supplies. Our SPA -Tacular portion is designed to inspire a love of health & wellbeing for a girls' mind, body, & soul. We will be incorporating mindfulness, self-care, relaxation, and fun. They will learn how to meditate, creatively visualize, and use stress relieving exercises in their daily lives. Campers will create multiple therapeutic and nature art projects (mandala rock painting, fluid paint pours, dream catchers, watercolor Neuro-Graphic art, mixed media dream board, and several other art projects designed to calm their nervous system. They will design a beautiful journal and make a designer pen. They will also make their own natural spa products (face mask, scrub, body lotion, body mist and lip balm. They will learn about basic hygiene, get pampered with an organic face mask (they make manicures and pedicures). They will make their own customized hand mirror, tote bag, sleep mask, dream pillow, empowering bracelet, decorate their own flip flops. They will be able to relax and read magazines, as well as participate in yoga. The Girls will learn how to put out more positive energy into the world through their words and actions. Wear yoga attire and bring a yoga mat or towel. Our programming inspires selfexpression through art and games. life coach and art educator, Angelique will lead girl talks on handling stress, anxiety, self-esteem, friendships, social responsibility & leadership.

Each day, students will create a masterpiece and use different art mediums such as liquid ink, watercolor, acrylic, mixed media, pastels, colored pencils, oil paint pens, pen, and ink, plus, plus. They will also learn the principles of line, tone, perspective, color, and composition. They will practice still life, portraits, contour drawing, and Manga, cartoon drawings. They will get to experiment with different paint splatters and fluid pours. They will learn about art history, art styles and be inspired by some of the greatest artists from around the world. On the last day our young artists will have their very own gallery showing of their art they made from camp with their friends and family.



Slime, Potions & Fluid Art CAMP (July 29-Augu. 2)

Get ready for a SLIMEY GOOD TIME!!! Creative Joy Art Studio has the largest Slime bar in Southern California, and we are so excited at this camp we will be teaching our campers about how to combine science with art in making incredible Non-Newtonian fluids (Slime). We will be making fluffy, butter, cloud, water, cereal, thick and glossy, galaxy, edible, glow in the dark slime plus adding in all of the charms, glitter and fun toys. We will make slime art and will also be getting slimed with raincoats on (Nickelodeon style). We will be experimenting with some super cool potion creations and all things Fluid art techniques. We will also hopefully be able to go on a field trip to The Sloomo Institute which will be opening up this Summer across the street from the Grove. (this will depend on if they are open yet and if Parents can carpool to pick them up and drop off. It will be an additional cost).

"CEO Entrepreneur" Camp (August 5th-9th) This camp is designed to empower campers to explore the world of entrepreneurship. Kids will create their own products, sell at a real "Pop-Up Boutique" and keep all of their PROFITS! We will also award a Grand Prize

\$100 Gift Card to the Winner of Sales at the Pop Up. All participants will be awarded a certificate of completion and recognized.

Our progressive curriculum allows returning students to learn new advanced business skills. This program is experiential and fun. It fosters creativity, teaches planning and decision making. Role playing, learning how to sell products and S-E-L (social emotional learning) builds self-confidence and leadership skills.

<u>Monday-</u> Our campers will learn how to create a business in their community, utilizing their interests and talents. They will participate in a master mind session to create a fabulous product line (fashion, accessories, and home décor or personal care items). A list will be sent to you to choose from, name/brand and business plan. They will learn about supply and demand, competition, distribution, branding, cost, profit and how to be unique in the marketplace. They will start creating their first products that day. They will also see and hear about other successful Entrepreneurs and how they became so successful. Each camper will receive their very own Entrepreneur Handbook.

<u>Tuesday-</u> Campers will learn about how to raise capital and create a financial plan. We will have a financial expert come in and teach the basics about saving, investing (real estate, stocks, bonds, etc.), giving back and the difference between bad interests on debt vs. good interest you earn. Each camper will learn how to write a check, balance a check book and understand debit cards vs. credit cards. Each camper will create a fabulous wallet and also, work on their product line for half of the day.

<u>Wednesday-</u> Marketing Magic- Campers will create a marketing/advertising strategy for their product line based on their target market. They will shoot a commercial, come up with a print campaign, social media strategy, make their business cards, create their sign for their pop up boutique, and work on their product line to sell at their Pop Up store on Friday.

Thursday- Our young entrepreneurs will learn about the skill of SELLING, connecting with your customers, providing great customer service, ethics, social responsibility and operating by the "Golden Rule." They will learn all about people skills, developing rapport, understanding different personality types, eye contact, smiling, gestures, voice tone and social etiquette. They will also learn how to put together a DREAM TEAM of support. They will also work on their product line for their Grand Opening Pop-up Store on Friday.

<u>Friday-GRAND OPENING DAY- Join us for the Official Pop-Up Store!</u> Campers practice their presentation – Put the finishing touches on their products, merchandise and set up their store. Each business owner needs to bring \$30-\$50 in change and a decorated cash box/shoe box. Invite all of your friends and family to come out and SHOP!!! Refreshments will be served.

<u>Material Cost Fee is an additional \$50</u> (we can shop for your child or we can give you a list and you can shop for the materials (Michaels, Dollar Tree, etc.)



Dollhouse & Castle Designer Camp (August 12-16)

Each designer will choose to create and decorate a doll house or castle and everything in it including the people and animals that might live in it. It will be an amazing week of creative and Design imagination! We will have fun designing a tiny home with tiny people living in it! Each child receives a large wooden dollhouse or castle and spends the week first creating a floor plan, then painting and crafting furniture and finally decorating each room! We are wallpapering rooms, laying carpet, hanging light fixtures, stuffing pillows miniature food and even a backyard wonderland. - How to be a positive role model
